On the deed Steve was known as Stef. They had also acquired property at 750 Simpson Avenue, Kansas City, Kansas, USA and was sold (as part of this divorce) to Anna and John Peter Myszka, Jr., for \$500. Mary received the residence at 3098 N. 12th Street, Kansas City, Kansas, USA and Steve received the \$500 from the sale of 750 Simpson Avenue, Kansas City, Kansas, USA.
